National Child Passenger Safety Week is in September

Car accidents are a leading cause of accidental injury and death for children under age 13.

- In 2016 more than 116,000 children were injured in car accidents.
- Using the appropriate car seat reduces the chance of infant and toddler fatalities by 71% and 54%, respectively.
- It is critical that the manufacturer's instructions be followed, and that children are always in the correct seat for their size and weight.
