First grade fun this week!

Language Arts:

- We began reading groups this week. Along with the Reading Workshop model of teaching reading, we will also have groups to address the needs of all students at all levels. The title 1 teachers, Mrs. Derosier and Mr. Burriss, will help by taking small groups as well. Groups will be held Monday and Tuesday each week.
- We learned about digraphs in Foundations. Students learned that a digraph is two letters together that make one sound. They are, sh, th, wh, ck and ch.
- We learned that ck comes only at the end of words after a short vowel

Math:

- We began unit 2 and have focused on instantly recognizing dots on dominoes and dice
- We focused on grouping dots together and using strategies we know to add the dots together rather than counting by 1's
- We solved and wrote story problems using tens frames and unifix cubes
- We continue to collect pattern blocks and record the data on the Data Collection Graph
- We are learning to write number sentences comparing two numbers using the greater than, less than and equal signs
