Dear Families,

Happy fall! Here's what happened in First grade this week!

Language Arts:

- We finished unit 1 of Foundations-We will begin unit 2 on Monday
- We continued to learn about good reading habits. So far we have learned:
 - Always begin with a sneak peak
 - Make predictions about what you learned during the sneak peak
 - Check your predictions as you read the book
 - Do something at the end
 - Reread
 - Find your favorite page and read it in your best story-telling voice
 - Retell the story using a finger for each detail
 - Read more and more
 - Set goals
 - Scoop up words in phrases
- We practiced partner reading. We learned:
 - To work together as a team
 - To build good habits together
 - To read together whether it be choral reading, echo reading or see-saw reading
 - To give each other friendly reminders
- In Writing Workshop we continue to learn about choosing interesting topics and zooming in on small moments
- We practiced letter formation, using uppercase letters at the beginning of sentences and leaving spaces between words

Math:

- We solved story problems using our number racks and white boards.
- We practiced telling our strategy first then giving the answer when solving all math problems
- We completed the mid-unit checkpoint for unit 1
- Three new workplace activities were introduced-Flip and Write, Ten and More and Which Coin Will Win?
- The "teens" family was introduced during Number Corner
- We continue to collect pennies and nickels and add them to our collection graph.
- The terms greater than, less than, equal to, most and least were introduced during Number Corner
- We practiced using the terms to compare the weekly totals on our collection graph
- We counted by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's

Science:

- We discussed what a Scientist is
- Each student carefully observed a leaf and created a scientific drawing of their leaf
- We completed "I noticed" statements about our leaves as a way to share what we learned and observed
- We will begin a unit on the moon next week

Social Skills:

- We finished reading the Incredible Flexible You series. The series includes:
 - Thinking Thoughts and Feeling Feelings
 - The Group Plan
 - Thinking with Your Eyes
 - Body in the Group
 - Whole Body Listening
- Voted on Classroom Citizen of the Week

Classroom Citizen of the Week:

Each week when a new friend is voted as our Classroom Citizen of the Week, we have a conversation about all the wonderful things that student did! We also talk about mistakes people make. Each of our friends is not perfect. We all make mistakes; it is how we learn. It's what we do with those mistakes that makes a difference. I think it's important for children to understand that being "perfect" isn't always best! This conversation is a nice way to reflect on the classroom and school expectations. It also gives others concrete examples of things they should be doing each day as a productive student! We've talked about how everyone will be voted for eventually and to strive to do their best ALWAYS. I let them know that I recognize all of the wonderful things each of them do EVERY SINGLE DAY! I also mention that it's important to keep persevering and if they are consistently making good choices, working hard, strategizing, solving conflicts in a respectful way, using kind words and thinking of others, they WILL get voted for. We ALL notice!
